Spring Leaves

APRIL 18: The city's spring leaf collection will begin Monday, April 18 and homeowners should have leaves, bagged or loose, at the curbline by 7:30 a.m. of that date. Public Works crews will make one complete route of the community for this spring pick-up.

Rabies Clinic

MAY 7: The annual rabies innoculation Clinic will be held Saturday, May 7, 9 a.m. to noon, at the rear of City Hall (garage area). Animals will be given 3 yr. inoculations for \$3.00. It is not necessary to inoculate dogs that received 3 yr. shots last year. However, annual licenses, due July 1, will also be available at the clinic (\$2.00 City and \$1.00 County). It would be helpful for owners to bring County expiration notice. (Remember, license should be secured to a collar on the dog at all times.)

City to Buy Ambulance

Your Webster Groves city council has approved plans to begin a municipal emergency ambulance service, to be directed by the Fire Department and to commence operation by July.

Bids are being reviewed for a modular-style ambulance, and additional firemen will be hired to supplement this new service. It is proposed that the city ambulance will transport sick and injured to selected area hospitals, to be chosen on a basis of emergency-room facilities and travel distance.

Many citizens have urged the city to respond to this need, but a decision on financing has not been reached. It may be supported by a service charge or a tax rate increase, or a combination of both.
